The majority of the information about these emigrants is from the 1921 Biography Yearbook of the Hadeland Lag.

*Family 164, form 138: **Ole Hansen** (Ole H. Nass), b. Sept. 15, 1840 in Brandbu, d. Dec. 26, 1919 in Decorah, IA. We have information about him and his family, but nothing about his siblings:*

1. Anders Hansen. b. Dec. 12, 1826 at Røkeneiet in Brandbu, d. 1879 in USA, emigr. April 29, 1865 with wife, Birthe Johnsdr.. b. May 12, 1826 and the children, Hans b. Sept. 5, 1855, John, b. Dec. 12, 1857 and Anders. b. Mar. 24, 1860.
2. Hans Hansen. b. Feb. 2, 1829 at Røkeneiet, d. 1903 in USA, emigr. Apr. 20, 1865 with wife Berthe Gudbrandsdtr., b. Oct. 6, 1827 and the children, Hans b. July 17, 1858 and Anne, b. Dec. 30, 1860.
3. Mari, b. Dec. 22, 1823 at Røkeneiet, emigr. date? d. 1894 in USA.

*Family 165, form 139: **Knud Nilsen Kanethaugen**. b. July 29, 1834 at Giefseneiet in Gran, emigr. April 4, 1861 with wife, Birthe Christophersdtr., b. Apr. 16, 1834 and the children, Mari b. Nov. 20, 1858 and Elina, b. Oct. 29, 1960. They lived first in Argyle, WI where they had 3 more children, Christian, Nils and Clara. Knud and Birthe lived in Minneapolis about 1910-1920. Knud's half-siblings, Lars Nilsen, b. April 24, 1849, lived in Manistee, MI and Mari (Mrs. Mary Olson), b. Mar. 16, 1851, lived in Chicago about 1920. No death records.*

*Family 166, form 142: **Amund Olsen**, b. Apr. 4, 1860 at Askimeiet in Tingelstad, emigr. July 20, 1871 with his mother, Bergit Knudsdr., b. Oct. 18, 1832 in Aal in Hallingdal and siblings, Oline (Miss Oline Amundson) to Decorah, IA, b. Oct. 6, 1866 and Marthe, b. Feb. 27, 1870. Lived in Argyle and Blanchardville, WI. About 1910-1920 in Deronda, WI. Also Amund's father, Ole Amundsen, b. June 27, 1837 emigrated. He died June 22, 1899 in USA. Amund's other siblings in USA:*

1. Kari, b. Oct. 9, 1862 (Mrs. Kari Thomas in Brainerd, MN);
2. Anne Maria, b. Feb. 21, 1864 (Mrs. Annie Olson in New Richmond, WI); and
3. Birthe, b. Apr. 29, 1868 (Mrs. Betsy Peterson in New Richmond, WI).

We are missing further records about all of them.

*Family 167, form 143: **Martin Olsen**, b. June 10, 1841 at Grinagereiet, emigr. with his wife, Anne Marie Halvorsdtr., b. Jan. 27, 1846 at Almseiet and the children: Birthe Maria, b. Dec. 25, 1865, Pauline, b. Jan. 27, 1869, Hilda, b. Dec. 17, 1871 and Oline, b. Aug. 3, 1873. They lived 2 years in Hudson, WI, later in Star Prairie, WI, where Martin died Oct. 10, 1903. No death date for Anne Marie. Hilda married Peter C. Horgan, see form 45, we know about them. Mrs. Pauline Nelson and Miss Mary Olson lived in Long Beach, CA in 1951, their brother, Otto Albert, lived in Star Prairie in 1920, 7 children had died before 1920.*

*Family 168, form 144: **Juul Olsen**. b. Sept. 20, 1845 at Eggeeiet in Brandbu, emigr. April 4, 1869. First he lived 2 years in Janesville, later in Polk Co. WI. Juul was a farmer and carpenter. His half-sister, Maren Olsdtr., b. Jan. 1, 1829, emigr. in 1854. We have no other information about them.*

*Family 169, form 146: **Lars Olsen** (L. C. Olson). b. Apr. 21, 1850 at Lofsvoldeiet in Gran, emigr. in Apr. 1870 to Argyle, WI. He lived some years in Blanchardville, WI, then back to Argyle where he died Dec. 28, 1913. Lars got married 1875 to Ingeborg Olsen Tvedt from Numedal and had 7 children. We have no records about them.*

- Lars' parents, Ole Christensen, b. Nov. 16, 1819 at Almseiet and Kirsti Johnsdr., b. Aug. 14, 1812 at Sandviken in Jevnaker emigr. in 1869 with their daughter, Ingeborg. (Mrs. Jakobsen), b. May 15, 1846, they lived in Argyle, too.
- Lars' brother, Christen (C. C. Olson), b. Apr. 20, 1844 at Dæhleneiet emigr. in 1867 to Argyle. He got married Apr. 19, 1874 to Marie Gundersen from Sigdal. They had 7 children and lived in Blanchardville, WI. No death records for other than Lars.

*Family 170, form 147: **Ole Olsen**. b. Aug. 30, 1839 at Raastadeiet in Gran, emigr. Apr. 21, 1869 with wife Margrete Christophersdr., b. Nov. 11, 1841 at Almseiet and the children:*

1. Trine Emilie Caroline, b. Feb. 23, 1866
2. Anton Ole Christian, b. Aug. 24, 1868.

Also Margrete's son, Christopher Hansen. b. Jan. 1, 1861

Ole's mother, Kari Olsdr., b. Sept. 27, 1807 and her second husband, Hans Borgersen, b. Aug. 12, 1827 in Gran, emigr. the same day. When Margrete died about 1917 in Decorah, IA, she had these children: Chris Alm in Decorah, IA; Thorvald in Winnipeg, Canada; Louis Olsen in Calmar, IA and two daughters. Nothing else about them from America.

*Family 171, form 151: **Olaus Andersen** (O. A. Opperud). b. May 7, 1862 at Halvorsrudeiet in Jevnaker, emigr. Apr. 15, 1880. He first lived 2 years in Jackson Co. MN, then in Minneapolis. Olaus' siblings:*

1. Maria, b. Apr. 30, 1848, emigr. with her second husband, Ole Olsen, b. ? in Adal? Also Maria's children, Anne Helene, b. Mar. 10, 1873 and Inga Annette. b. July 26, 1875 emigr. ? Their father was Kristian Haavelsen from Biri. Ole Olsen's children from his first marriage. Karen Oline, b. 1868 and Anton, b. 1871 emigr. also.
2. Peder, b. Feb. 6, 1851 at Halvorsrudeiet, emigr. 1881 with his wife, Karen Eriksdr., b. Dec. 8, 1848 at Bergereiet in Jevnaker and the children: Gina Anette, b. 1876 and Emil Anton, b. Oct. 8, 1878.
3. Ingeborg Margrethe, b. June 15, 1857 at Halvorsrudeiet, emigr. 1881.

Have no information about them from America.

*Family 172, form 152: **Anders Iversen** (A. I. Olerud), b. Mar. 22, 1891 in Lovlien in Moen, Tingelstad, emigr. 1910, d. 1966 in Cass County, ND, married 1921 to Berthe Marie Eriksdr., b. Mar. 20, 1890 in Rognstad in Moen, emigr. 1914, d. 1996 in Cass Co. ND. We have records for them. A. I. Olerud's aunt and uncles in America:*

1. Anne Andersdr., b. Nov. 12, 1851 at Tuffseiet in Gran, emigr. ? married to Martin Larson. They lived in Delavan, MN in 1920.
2. Peder Andersen (Peder Lee). b. June 23, 1856 in Lovlien, emigr. 1884 with wife Johanne Olsdr.. b. July 28, 1854 at Egge in Brandbu and the children: Anders, b. June 27, 1877, Olaf, b. June 25, 1880 and Berthe Maria. b. Sept. 27, 1882. Peder lived in Hudson, WI.
3. Johannes Andersen, b. Sept. 15, 1858 in Løvlien, emigr. 1883,4. Anders Andersen (Andrew Lee). b. June 27, 1863 in Løvlien, emigr. 1883, lived in Wentworth, WI in 1920.

No other information from their life in America.

Mikkelsen d. Feb. 4, 1866 in Gran. Randi and Ole had many children who emigr., we have no information about them.

1. Mikkel, b. Oct. 1, 1831, emigr. 1867 with wife, Berthe Christensdtr.. b. Sept. 9, 1834, and children: Kari b. May 11, 1862 and Randi, b. Oct. 2, 1864.
2. Peder. b. Apr. 10, 1837
3. Carl, b. June 12, 1841, emigr. 1861
4. Johanne, b. Jan. 26, 1847
5. Mari, b. June 17, 1849, emigr. 1868
6. Martin, b. June 28, 1851, emigr. July 3, 1873 to St. Peter
7. Ole, b. July 29, 1854, emigr. 1868
8. Gunder, b. May 30, 1856, emigr. 1867.

*Family 174, form 157: **Peder Paulsen Thon**. b. about 1828 at Ringerike, emigr. 1854 with wife, Lisbet Olsdtr., b. Sept. 14, 1826 at Ballangrud in Lunner and children:*

1. Sophie. b. Sept. 10, 1850
2. Oline. b. Mar. 27, 1852
3. Randi, b. Feb. 10, 1854. They lived in Argyle, WI.

Peder and Randi also had a son, Ole, b. Nov. 21, 1859 in Argyle who married Mar. 4, 1889 to Jane Sorum. They had 4 children and lived in Blanchardville, WI. No more information.

*Family 175, form 158: **Christian Iverson** (Christ Phillipson). b. Feb. 27, 1853 at Prestkvern in Brandbu, emigr. May 18, 1883, settled in Argyle, WI. He was a carpenter.*

- His sister Marthe (Mrs. Johnson), b. Mar. 22, 1845, lived in Argyle, no date for emigr.
- His sister, Anne (Mrs. Reinard Jackson), b. Sept. 26, 1850, lived in Argyle where she died Sept. 7, 1916, see form 95.

*Family 176, form 160: **Gudbrand Pedersen Brynsaas** (Gilbert Peterson). b. Apr. 17, 1816 at Dvergstenseiet, had emigr. 1854 with wife Anne Maria Pedersdtr., b. Sept. 23, 1818 at Gulstuen in Brandbu and children:*

1. Peder, b. Feb. 7, 1841 (Peder used the name Peter Gilbertson while serving in the Army during the Civil War)
2. Marthe, b. Oct. 4, 1847
3. Johanne. b. Feb. 2, 1850.

They also had a son born on the ocean, Martin, b. May, 17, 1854. Martin married Apr. 11, 1879 to Ingeborg Sjursdtr. Bakkethun (Brekkehus) and they lived in Fertile, MN. He died Dec. 9, 1924. They had no children. Gudbrand's sister, Randi Pedersdtr., see family 173.

Gudbrand's half-brother, Torger Pedersen, b. Apr. 24, 1825, emigr. 1853 with wife, Goro Pedersdtr., b. Jan. 1, 1820 and their son Anders, b. Dec. 18, 1851. Torger died in Nicollet County, MN, no other records from USA.

*Family 177, form 161: **Christen Pedersen**. b. Dec. 11, 1821 at Dvergstenseiet, (brother of Torger, see family 176), emigr. 1851 with wife Anne Larsdtr., b. Nov. 29, 1816 at Almseiet and children:*

1. Johanne, b. July 1, 1843
2. Twins Anne and Birthe, b. Feb. 16, 1850.

They first lived in Koshkonong, Dane Co, WI where their son, S. O. Peterson was born Mar. 27, 1853. They lived from 1856 in Brighton, MN and later in St. Paul, MN. Christen's father, Peder Carstensen, b. 1885, emigr. 1853. No other information about marriage and death for this family.

Lived 8 years in Hudson, SD, later in ND. Their children: a) Erik. b. Jan. 14, 1866, emigr. 1887, lived in Hudson, SD. b) Ole, b. Oct. 19, 1867, emigr. 1888, lived in Montana, c) Mari, (Mrs. Pfluger), b. Aug. 2, 1869, emigr. 1890, lived in Carson, ND, d) Anders, b. Nov. 12, 1871, emigr. 1889, lived in Hudson, SD, have records for his wife and children, e) Christian, b. Mar. 26, 1879, emigr. 1890, f) Anne Marie, b. Mar. 24, 1881, emigr. 1890. Missing information about children and death records for all except of the father, Even Rossum. Even's brother, Ole, b. May 13, 1840, see form 164; Even's brother, Knud E. Rossum, b. May 24, 1848, lived in Lake Park, MN, missing his death record.*

*Family 180, form 166: **Gulbrand Torstensen Runden**, b. Feb. 27, 1832 at Braaumsmoen and wife, Anne Christensdtr., b. Nov. 12, 1828 at Slettmoen in Brandbu, emigr. 1883 with children: a) Anna b. Nov. 20, 1856, b) Christian, b. Apr. 13, 1861, c) Torsten, b. Jan. 31, 1864, lived in Hayward, MN; e) Kari b. June 3, 1866, lived in Albert Lea, MN; f) Marte, b. Oct. 28, 1868, lived in Glenville, MN; g) Johan, b. Sept. 3, 1871 and h) Anton, b. Jan. 27, 1874, both lived in Hayward, MN. Have marriage and names of the children for Johan and Anton, no other records.*

Aug. 30, 1876, d. Jan. 16, 1916 in Fargo, ND; b) Caroline, b. Dec. 19, 1878, c) Olave, b. Nov. 19, 1881, d) Anna, b. June 10, 1884, e) Gina, b. Jan. 1, 1887 and f) Sofie, b. Nov. 8, 1889. A son, Melvin, b. 1892 in ND. They lived in Milan, Chippewa Co., MN. The children in 1916: Mrs. Steen, Danvers; Mrs. John Olson, Mrs. Peter H. Larson and Mrs. Hans Nordby, all in Town of Westbank, Mrs. Peter Stelling, Sask. Can. Melvin Retrum lived at the home farm. Anders' siblings in USA: Kari. b. May 2, 1864, emigr. 1884, lived in Swift Co., MN; Iver, b. July 8, 1866, emigr. 1884, lived in Lake Wilson, MN and Karen. b. May 14, 1882, emigr. 1899, lived in Montevideo, MN. No information about children or deaths.*

*Family 182, form 169: **Hans Andersen Rekstad**, b. Apr. 26, 1889 at Rækstadeiet in Tingelstad, emigr. 1907, lived 4 years in Watson, MN, then in Willow Lake, SD. Carpenter. His brother Karl b. Mar. 10, 1893, emigr. 1913, and the half-brother, Anton, b. Dec. 20, 1870, emigr. 1889, lived in Montevideo, MN. Missing information about them.*

*Family 183, form 170: **Ole Iversen Rognstad**, b. Feb. 10, 1842 and wife, Johanne Halvorsdtr.. b. Mar. 4, 1841, had one daughter, Anne. b. Aug. 31, 1865 in Gran. No date for emigr. The Biography book from 1910/1920 tells that Ole lived in Clarkfield, MN and the children were: Halvor. 47. Kristian. 42. Maren. 40. Anton. 37. Olaf. 35. Emma. 31 years old. Ole said he emigr. in 1876 ? with "Manila." Ole's brother, Paul Iversen, b. July 3, 1847, lived in Montevideo, MN about 1910/1920. Missing records for emigr., children and death.*

*Family 184, form 171: **Anders O. Rossum**, b. July 13, 1888 at Raassum in Brandbu, emigr. 1907, lived in Balfour, ND about 1920. Siblings: a) Marius, b. Oct. 16, 1889, emigr. 1906, lived in Medicine Hat, Alta., Can; b) Nils, b. May 18, 1891, emigr. 1906, lived in Churches Ferry, ND; c) Valborg, b. Apr. 5, 1893, emigr. 1912, lived in Churches Ferry, ND; d) Torgeir, b. Aug. 23, 1895, emigr. 1912, lived in Seven Persons, Alta., Can. Also their mother, Anne Lise Torgersdtr., b. Dec. 17, 1864 emigr. The mother's sisters, a) Karen, b. Jan. 19, 1867, emigr. 1887, married to a GermanAmerican, died in Minneapolis before 1921, b) Marie, b. May 19, 1874, married to Hartvig Hoff from østfold, emigr., lived in Chicago. The father's brother, Hans Andersen, b. Mar. 24, 1866 at Raassum, emigr. 1888. He lived in Balfour, ND in 1920. Missing a lot of records for this family.*

*Family 185, forms 179 and 180: **Christopher Torgersen Smedshammer**, b. Dec. 9, 1851 emigr. 1881 with wife Kjersti Gulbrandsdtr. Kjos, b. Dec. 14, 1854. Lived in Litchville, La Moure Co. ND. Kjersti died June 30, 1904, missing death date for Christopher. The twin brother, Bent T. Smedshammer, emigr. 1881 with wife Kari Olsdtr. Kjos, b. Oct. 10, 1857. She died Apr. 12, 1898 in Litchville, missing death record for Bent. Kari's siblings, Nils O. Kjos, b. Apr. 12, 1850, emigr. 1869 and Anders, b. Jan. 8, 1853, emigr. 1875, no information about them.*

*Family 186, form 181: **Peder A. Sorum**, b. Feb. 16, 1865 at Sorumsengen in Tingelstad, emigr. 1888. Lived in Sioux Falls and in Canton, SD from 1900, married 1899 to Anna Nilsine Larsdtr., b. Oct. 8, 1867 at Sanne in Gran, emigr. 1881 with parents Lars Andersen, b. Aug. 9, 1842 in Drammen and Anette Nilsdtr. Holt, b. Mar. 9, 1846 in Hønefoss, died? and siblings, Olaf. b. Oct. 19, 1869, Carl, b. Nov. 18, 1871, Alf b. Dec. 13, 1874, all b. in Gran and Fritz b. 1880 in Oslo. About 1920 Olaf and Carl had died, Alf lived in Mankato, MN, Fritz in Mitchell, SD and a brother, Ralph, lived in Minneapolis. P.A. Sorum's siblings: a) Pernille A. Haug, see form 83; b) Randi. (Mrs. Christie), b. Nov. 24, 1861, emigr. 1878, lived in Lanesboro, MN; c) Marie, (Mrs. Grevlos), b. May 20, 1870, emigr. ?, lived in Canton, SD; d) Hilda, (Mrs. Ullberg), b. Mar. 30, 1873, emigr. 1890, lived in Mott, ND. The only death date we have is for Lars Andersen who died Nov. 2, 1913 in Mankato, MN.*

*Family 187, form 182: **Halvor Pedersen**, b. Sept. 26, 1817 at Røisumseiet in Tingelstad, and wife Kirsti Olsdtr., b. Nov. 22, 1820 at Bergsrudeiet in Gran, emigr. 1877 with children: a) Peder, b. Apr. 11, 1859 and b) Randi Maria, b. Sept. 2, 1865. Peder lived in Jamestown, ND in 1928, Randi Maria, d. Feb. 13, 1928 in Greenwood, Clark Co., WI, married 1882 to Tron Olsen Windom, see form 1138. Halvor and Kirsti's other children in USA: a) Karen, b. May, 3, 1845, emigr. before 1873, she married Nicolai Wigtil and they had 3 children. Karen had a daughter, Anne Hansdtr., b. Jan. 1, 1869 at Røisumseiet, who emigr. 1877 with her grandparents. Anne married Christian Bjerkan and died 1948 in Walcott, ND. b) Ole, b. June 2, 1850 and c) Oline, b. Jan. 10, 1855, may also have emigrated?*

*Family 188, form 183: **Iver Andersen Sorum**, b. Mar. 4, 1860 at Sorum in Bjoneroa, emigr. 1880 and settled in Clarkfield, MN. Married 1889 to Kjersti Bredesdtr. Moistad, b. in Clarkfield. We have the names of their children, but missing death records. Iver's siblings in USA: a) Martha, b. Jan. 23, 1862, see form 52, b) Anne Maria, (Mrs. O. Sørenson), b. May 1, 1868, emigr. 1888; c) Thorvald, b. June 15, 1873, emigr. ?; d) Christian, b. June 24, 1875, emigr. ? e) Martinus, b. Mar. 10, 1879, emigr. ? They all lived in Clarkfield about 1920. Missing information about marriage, children and death for the siblings of Iver.*

*Family 189, form 186: **Ole Monsen Steen**, b. May 12, 1860 at Tuffseiet in Gran, emigr. 1882, settled in Clay Co., MN. Married 1885 to Ingeborg Pedersdtr. and they had 4 children: Ida,*

Gustav, Anna and Olga. Ole's brother, Gudbrand Monsen, b. Mar. 18, 1853 at Tuffseiet, and wife Ingeborg Pedersdtr., b. June 1, 1848 at Dvergstenseiet, emigr. 1875 with their son Mons. b. Oct. 1, 1874. Ole was farmer, clerk at the school district for 20 years, president of board of supervisors and lived in Moorhead about 1920. Was his wife, Ingeborg, first married to his brother Gudbrand? Missing death records for all of them.

*Family 190, form 187: **Lars Olsen Storskogen**, b. Aug. 1, 1840 at Bolkeneiet in Lunner and wife Marthe Olsdtr., b. Mar. 29, 1839 at Larmerud in Lunner, emigr. 1869 and settled in WI. Marthe d. 1887 in Polk Co. and Lars remarried 1888 to Ingeborg Andersdtr., b. Oct. 10, 1846 at Bjøralteiet in Lunner, see form ill. One son, Olaf, b. July 4, 1889. No death records, and we also are missing a lot of information about Ingeborg's family, see form 111.*

Aug. 1957 in Hitterdal. Their children in 1957: Harry, Arthur and Floyd in Hitterdal; Melvin in Moorhead, MN; Dennis in Glyndon, MN; Mrs. Sig. Winstiyy in Perham, MN; Mrs. Melvin Peterson and Mrs. Joseph Klemetson in Ulen, MN. Who were Gustav's parents? (Decorah Posten June 3, 1954 and Aug. 24, 1957)*

Emigrants from the Mjør farm we are missing information about: Peder Andersen, b. Oct. 4, 1834, emigr. 1870 with wife Karen Ellingsdtr., b. Feb. 2, 1845 and children Kirsti, b. Sept. 13, 1863, Maria, b. Jan. 1, 1866 and Anders, b. June 5, 1868. Peder's siblings: Jens, b. Mar. 8, 1836, emigr. 1866, Gudbrand, b. Aug. 29, 1847, emigr. 1869, Brek, b. July 27, 1849, emigr. 1866, Martin Andreas, b. Apr. 4, 1855, emigr. 1888. No info about any of these Mjør brothers.

*Family 192: **Mrs. O. G. Nelson**, b. Sept. 12, 1856? in Hadeland, d. 1933 in Hatton, ND, emigr. 1875, man. 1877, settled in Morgan twp., ND in 1878. *Family 194, form 192: **Christen Gudmundsen** (C. G. Svenning), b. June 28, 1863 in Brandbu, emigr. 1884. He was a farmer and businessman in Albert Lea, Freeborn Co., MN in 1920. Married 1891 to Berte Olina Bagaasen and they had 5 daughters, b. in Albert Lea, see form 192. Christen's parents and other family members are on form 110. Missing death records.*

*Family 195, form 196: **Anders Pedersen** (Anders P. Svingen), b. Apr. 23, 1849 in Gran, d. July 14, 1937 in Montevideo, MN. Have info, about him. His parents, Peder Pedersen, b. Sept. 7, 1812 and Anne Pedersdtr., b. Jan. 11, 1812 in Gran, d. 90 years old in Montevideo, emigr. 1868. Anders' siblings: 1. Berte, b. May, 22, 1842, emigr. 1875 with her son Peter b. May 23, 1871; 2. Marthe, b. Mar. 13, 1846, emigr. 1869; 3. Jens, b. Oct. 4, 1853, emigr. 1868. No info about them.*

*Family 196, form 198: **Iver Sørensen**, b. Dec. 18, 1843 in Jevnaker, emigr. 1868. Married to Sofie Eriksdtr. from Hakadal. They first farmed in Lafayette Co., WI, later in Garretson, SD. No other records for Iver. Iver's siblings, 1. Anne, b. Oct. 24, 1850, emigr. 1884. 2. Kari, b. The first 4 families are from the Rowberg files. I have not been able to identify these emigrants.

Family 197: Martin O. Peterson, Argyle, WI, born at Hadeland, died 88 years old. He emigr. 1887 with his parents and settled in Lafayette Co. He married Rose Schemerhorn in Gratiot in 1889? Farmers in Lafayette until 1943 when they moved to Argyle. Rose died 1960. Children: Clyde and Leo in Argyle, Norman in Belmont, WI, Mrs. Mabel Whiteford in Mineral Point and Mrs. Esther Ripley in Chaston. 3 brothers: Ringwell in Wiota, Oscar in Monroe and Melvin in Argyle. (Decorah Posten Apr. 20, 1961.)

Family 198: George Rogne, b. 1888 in Lake Co. SD, attended Augustana Co. in Canton, planed to be a pastor, but ended up as a banktreasurer. He is a very good bankier and the farmers trust him. His father was from Hadeland and the mother from the area near Oslo. Written by Roy Jon Norstog in Skandinavien Aug. 1, 1917.

Family 199: Hans A. Rud, b. May 20, 1850 (wrong date?) in Gran, died May 11, 1932 in his home 10 miles North of Provoit, Alta, Canada. He came to Alta in 1914 with wife Kjersti Gundersdtr. Sletta, married 1885. Children: Gina in Livingstone; Marit and Carl near the home; Karine (Mrs. Alfred Lee) in Wilmette, IL; Albert Peter and Ted in the home; Oscar in North Brook, IL; Helen (Mrs. Robert Emsley) near the old home. (Dec. Posten June 24, 1932)

Family 200: Mrs. A. G. Olson (Agnes Peterson, wrong name?), b. 1855 in Hadeland, emigr. 1874, d. Jan. 1, 1919 in Glenwood, MN. Married 1874 to Albert G. Olson, b. in WI in 1845, d. 1916. Farmer and Sheriff in Pope Co. MN. Children: Martin in Williston, ND; Mrs. Julius Strøm in Alberta, Can: Mrs. Carl Nelson in Starbuck; Mrs. John Hanson in Jamestown, ND; Oscar and Irene at the home farm in 1916. (Skandinaven, May 12, 1916 and Jan. 15, 1919).

Family 201, form 199: Erik Christensen Tandberg, b. 1798 emigr. from Kløvstadeiet in Tingelstad 1853 with wife, Maria Olsdtr., b. 1800 and the children Anne, b. Apr. 15, 1826, Christian, b. Jan. 14, 1830, Ole Petter, b. Aug. 4, 1832, Maria, b. Jan. 28, 1835 and Hans, b. Jan. 5, 1842. They staid 3 1/2 year in Muskego, WI, later in Green Co. WI.

Their daughter Marthe, b. Nov. 24, 1822, emigr. 1852 with her husband Anders Larsen, b. Sept. 18, 1818 and their daughter Torina, b. June 11, 1847. We have records about Hans, see above, he married Karen Amundsdtr., b. Sept. 22, 1853 in Gran, emigr. 1872. They lived in Northwood, ND and died there in 1916 and 1918. No records for the others in this family.

Family 202, form 201: John Johnsen Kjøvlingstuen, b. 1807 emigr. from Lunner 1852 with wife Rønnaug Larsdtr., b. 1806 and children: Lars, b. Mar. 12, 1832, Abraham, b. Mar. 26, 1835, Andreas, b. Dec. 14, 1837, Hans, b. Nov. 6, 1840, Randi, b. Feb. 29, 1843, Johan, b. Jun. 27, 1845, Lise, b. July 11, 1847, Tobias, b. Sept. 20, 1849 and Lauritz, b. July 28, 1851.

The son, John, b. Jun. 11, 1829, emigr. 1850, mar. to Gulbjør, b. 1827. They died in 1918 and 1901, both buried at Yellowstone Luth. Cem. Lafayette Co. WI.

The son Abraham, see above, married 1856 to Inger Karine Johnsdr. They lived in Town of Argyle, Lafayette Co, had 8 children. Abraham was farmer, he died 1916, his wife died 1912,

both in Lafayette Co. About 1910, Abraham had these siblings: Mrs. Lisa Hanson in Bellingham, WA; John Johnson in Lake City, Texas; Tobias Johnson in MN; Mrs. Severson in Brockeneer, Oklahoma; Andreas Johnson in Darlington, WI. No more information.

Family 203, form 203: Marte Pedersdtr. (Mrs. Halvor I. Ulvik), b. Sept. 5, 1877 at Knudstad in Tingelstad, emigr. 1893. She died 1956 and is buried with her husband in Aneta, Nelson Co. ND. Marte's siblings in America: 1. Kari, (Mrs. Peter Hanson), b. Feb. 21, 1875, lived in Mayville, ND, 2. Anna Margrete, b. Sept. 22, 1882, emigr. 1902, 3. Ole (Ole Grymyr), b. July 31, 1885, emigr. 1905, lived in Crookston, MN, married to Mathila Olson and had 4 children. Ole died 1947, Mathilda died 1978, both in Minneapolis. 4. Ingeborg (Mrs. Arnold Olson), b. Mar. 2, 1887, emigr. 1905. They lived in Genesee, Idaho. Need more records about them.

Family 204, form 205: Hans Nilsen, b. Aug. 24, 1849, emigr. 1881 with wife Martine, 25 years old and daughter Kirsti, 4 years old. They settled in Limcoln, Nebraska. When Hans died in 1935, he was survived by his wife and 3 daughters, Mrs. Chris. Chutt, Ms. Mathilde and Mrs. Harry Wagner. Hans had 4 siblings in America: 1. Lars, b. Feb. 5, 1855, emigr. 1881, lived in Lincoln, NE in 1940. 2. Amund (Amund N. Framstad), b. May 7, 1861, emigr. 1882. He was maried in Chicago to Christine Haugen, had two daughters in 1940: Clara (Mrs. W. B. Riggs) in Norfolk, NE and Nina (Mrs. G. B. Hodges) in Omaha, NE. Amund married 2. time 1894 to Anne Marie Olson. They had the daughter, Mrs. Leo W. Kelly who lived in Chicago. Amund died Nov. 6, 1940 in Osage, IA, buried in Lincoln, NE. 3. Nils, b. June 25, 1863, emigr. 1886. 4. Kjersti, b. Dec. 23, 1856, emigr. 1886. She lived in Lincoln Co. NE in 1940. No more information.

Family 205, form 206: Berthe Torstensdtr., b. Jan. 1, 1821 at Hval in Gran, emigr. as a widow in 1881 together with her daughter Anne Amundsdtr., b. Jun. 28, 1854, Anne's husband, Lars Madsen, b. Feb. 28, 1854 and their children: Johanne Maria, b. Jan. 24, 1875, Birthe, b. Jan. 29, 1877 and Anders, b. Nov. 15, 1879. About 1910, Berthe lived in Clark Co. SD. Berthe's daughter, Kari, b. Jan. 16, 1851 emigr. 1874, see form 662. She died Sept. 3, 1881 in Ellsworth, MN together with 2 of her children. No more records.

Family 206, form 213 and 573: Hans Paulsen (Hans P. Winden), b. Feb. 2, 1842 in Gran, emigr. 1869. He settled in Blanchardville, Lafayette Co. WI. Mar. 1880 to Maren Nilsdtr., b. 1850. Maren died 1895, Hans died 1926, both buried at Yellowstone Luth. Cem. Han's sister, Berte, b. Apr. 10, 1830, emigr. 1876 with her husband, Anders Gudbrandsen (A. G. Winden), b. Mar. 20, 1840 and children: Caroline, b. Nov. 30, 1863, Gusta Pauline, b. Jan. 12, 1869, Iver, b. Jul. 29, 1871 and Julius, b. Apr. 30, 1874. See form 573. Destination: Monroe, WI. No information. Han's brother, Iver, b. May 7, 1833 in Gran, emigr. 1871 with his wife Ingeborg Pedersdtr., b. dec. 19, 1836 and children: Paul, b. Aug. 18, 1861, Anders, b. Jun. 4, 1864 and Kirsti, b. Sept. 7, 1867. Destianation: Milwaukee. No information about them.
